Sound Speech – James 3

Introduction: It is no mere coincidence that the subject matter of our lesson finds itself directly in the middle of James' letter. It is here that a disciple will either continue to mature in their walk with the Lord, or they run the risk of losing all their gains (*Col. 3:23-24; Gal. 5:19-21*). It is here we must take to heart Proverbs 15:2 – *"The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out foolishness"*. This is why sound speech marks a maturing disciple.

James also uses many word pictures throughout this chapter that relates to the events after the rapture of the church - Fire of iniquity (3:6; Rev. 9:17); Bitter water (3:11; Rev. 8:11); Fig tree & olive tree (3:12; Rev. 6:13; 11:4); Sowing & Harvesting of peace (3:18; Rev. 21:4; 22:3; Mt. 5:9).
